## COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

October 24, 2020 12pm - 9pm

**It is the intention of the Greater Vail Area Chamber of Commerce, staff, vendors and participants that all attendees are provided a healthy and safe event.**

### Basic Rules

- ❖ All participants including staff, vendors and attendees must wear a mask.
  - Wear masks with two or more layers to stop the spread of COVID-19
  - Wear the mask over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin
  - Masks shall be worn by people five (5) years of age and older
- ❖ All staff, vendors and attendees will be greeted when they enter the facility.
  - Bodily temperatures of all will be taken upon entering. Anyone refusing or having a temperature higher than 101 will be denied access.
  - The following questions will be asked of every attendee:
    - Have you or anyone in your household been in close contact with someone with confirmed positive COVID-19 test in the last 14 days?
    - Have you or anyone in your household experienced any new or unexplained cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, or runny nose?
    - Have you or anyone in your household had unexplained muscle aches, headaches, fatigue, vomiting, diarrhea, or change in sense of smell or taste?
- ❖ A free event program which outlines all rules for COVID-19 mitigation will be handed out. This program will include a Pima County Health Notice – posting **“STOP Please do not enter if you have COVID-19 symptoms.** Entry security will verbally remind guests to maintain social distance and wear an approved face mask.
- ❖ All vendors will be provided signage reminding guests to maintain appropriate social distance separation and wear a mask while in their booth. Each vendor must post the sign at entry to their booth.
- ❖ Pima county and health department provided signage is posted at each property entrance for both participants and guests. Signage is also posted at bathrooms, concessions stands, vendor stations and guest tables.
- ❖ Staff will wear masks

### Vendor Rules

- ❖ Each non-food vendor will be allocated a 10 ft x 10 ft space for their booth. There will be a six-foot separation of booths. All vendors will wear masks and other necessary PPE
- ❖ Counters and other touch points in vendor booths will be sanitized by vendor each hour.
- ❖ Ten (10) food vendors will be present. Food vendors will sanitize and wipe down counters and surfaces every hour. Permits, COI and business license will be on file for the event. There will be a minimum six-foot separation of food vendors.
